Seven Core Principles of the Constitution Party

3. **Family**: One husband and one wife with their children as divinely instituted.
4. **Property**: Each individual's right to own and steward personal property without government burden.
5. **Constitution and Bill of Rights** interpreted according to the actual intent of the Founding Fathers.
6. **States' Rights**: Everything not specifically delegated by the Constitution to the federal government, nor prohibited by the Constitution to the states, is reserved to the states or to the people.
7. **American Sovereignty**: American government committed to the protection of the borders, trade, and common defense of Americans, and not entangled in untoward foreign alliances.
